# B. POP-Hanger Maintenance Standards.

- i. The following language regarding POP- Hanger Maintenance Standards should be added to the Rules and Regulations: "Owner agrees to maintain the Hanger in a neat, orderly and safe condition. The exterior of all structures upon the Premises shall be maintained free of rust, peeling paint, broken windows, or damaged roofing materials, panels, trim, doors and other exterior components. All dilapidated exterior components shall be repaired or replaced at the sole costs of the hanger owner. The interior of all structures on Premises shall be kept neat, clean and safe.
- ii. Mr. Brown made the motion to add the language above to the MCEAA Rules and Regulations. Mr. Cavin seconded the motion. The Authority approved the motion unanimously.
- C. Mr. Taylor made a motion to suspend the rules. Mr. Lynch seconded the motion. The Authority approved the motion unanimously.
